A leak was discovered on a buried produced water line at the subject location. Once the leak was discovered all wells coming into the battery were shut in and the treater lines were drained. A hydrovac was dispatched to location and the pipe was excavated and contaminated soil was removed. The cause of the spill was determined to be due to corrosion from standing fluid.
