Ladies and Gentlemen:

In accordance with section 305.b.(1) of the rules and regulations of the State of Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("COGCC"), this letter shall serve as formal 30-day notice by EnCana Energy Resources Inc. ("EnCana") of its intention to conduct drilling operations on the above referenced well in Boulder County, Colorado. As an operational matter a formal application for a Permit to Drill will initially be prepared and submitted to the COGCC under EnCana's statewide bond.

Operations are estimated to be beginning sometime with the next six (6) months, pending receipt of required permits, approval of title and drilling rig availability.

The well location will be staked prior to consultation; however, our representative, Peter Scott, will be available to consult with you prior to commencement of the operations to discuss the location of the wellsite, roads, production facilities and other related matters. Upon reaching a mutual agreement, EnCana will replace its bond with a Surface Owners Agreement. In absence of reaching a mutually satisfactory surface agreement within a thirty (30) day period, EnCana may elect to proceed with the commencement of operations under its statewide bond.

The COGCC regulations provide that the surface owner may waive the 30-day period notice requirement. Therefore, enclosed is an owner response form. Please review and indicate your preference with regard to the consultation requirement. Also enclosed is a self-addressed envelope for your convenience in returning your signed response. Please be advised that the well location will be staked prior to a consultation.

As the surface owner, it is your responsibility to notify any affected tenant farmer, lessee or other party that may own an interest in any crops or surface improvements that could be affected by these proposed operations.
