### INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

This form has been prepared to summarize assessment activities conducted during the plugging and abandonment of the Powers X22-67HN wellhead and the permanent removal of the associated off-location flowline. Assessment activities began on December 3, 2021. Soil assessment activities were conducted in accordance with COGCC Rule 911.a. A photo log is attached.

On December 3 and 7, 2021, soil samples were collected from the wellhead excavation, flowline potholes, and separator riser. The samples were field screened for total volatile organic compounds using a photoionization detector (PID). Based on PID readings at the flowline, separator riser, and base and sidewalls of the wellhead excavation, three soil samples were submitted for analysis. Analytical results indicated soil was in full compliance with Table 915 -1 standards at the extent of all excavations, except for pH at a level of 11.9. However, there are no indications of either historical or active releases at this location and the singular elevated pH result is not an indication of a release of hydrocarbons. Therefore, further excavation was not warranted. The wellhead excavation and flowline are depicted on Figures 1 and 2, respectively. The soil sample results and PID readings are summarized in Tables 1 and 2, respectively, and the laboratory reports are attached.

Following cut and cap operations, a soil gas survey was conducted. Five soil vapor points (SVP01 through SVP05) were installed adjacent to the former wellhead location. GEM 5000 field readings were non-detect for methane at for all soil vapor points. The soil vapor point locations are illustrated on Figure 1. The soil vapor field form is included as an attachment.
