Dear Mr. and Mrs. Anderson,

As agreed upon during the onsite conversation on March 30, 2021 concerning waiver of final reclamation on your property for the Buckskin Mesa Compressor Station, this letter documents the agreement between you and the COGCC regarding final reclamation.

The reasons you have provided for waiving COGCC's obligation to perform final reclamation on this OWP site include:

1. You intend to utilize the well site, access road and nearby areas for agricultural uses including but not limited to equipment and supply storage, possible future development and to provide vehicle access to your property for these same purposes and any others related to your ownership and/or development of your property.

By waiving the COGCC's obligations for final reclamation required under COGCC Rule 1004 as set forth in this letter agreement, you are acknowledging that the current condition of the portions of the access road and/or oil and gas location subject to the waiver is satisfactory to you. By executing below and agreeing to the change in land use set forth in this letter agreement you acknowledge that you are knowingly and forever waiving reclamation protections otherwise afforded by COGCC Rule 1004 and you assume responsibility for topsoil protection and any future reclamation of the land.
