### INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Historic Form 19 (2009): Contract crew employee was draining filtered produced water from a 4" poly line between Pond 4 and the 697-09-61 pad. The line was being drained to prevent damage due to freezing. The contract employee opened the valves and over-flowed the frac tank, due to an error in the strapping of the tank. All the filtered produced water was contained on the pad. Valves were closed and a water truck was mobilized to removed free fluids (10bbbls recovered).

Documentation of release area and or sampling not located from due diligence. A grid area with 50'x30' nodes is proposed covering the area where frac tanks would have sat during operations. PID screening at each point from 0-6" depth, if PID results are 500ppm a sample will be collected. If PID results are below 500ppm, 3 samples will be collected from highest reading location. Samples will be analyzed for table 915. See attached diagram.
