The Pronghorn 21-24-17HNB separator over pressured, blowing the rupture disc, and resulting in approximately 9 bbls of oil to mist to the southwest across the pad and into the neighboring property. The impacted soil and vegetation was removed and hauled to a COGCC approved disposal facility. Confirmation surficial soil samples were collected and submitted for laboratory analysis of TPH (C6-C36), organics in soil, and inorganics in soil in compliance with COGCC Table 915-1. Two waste characterization sample for metals were also submitted. Two background samples were collected for inorganics and metals analysis as well.			
Based on data collected through 5/2/22, all confirmation samples were in compliance with COGCC Table 915-1 and/or background comparisons (see arsenic and pH). BCEOC respectfully requests a NFA designation.
