Refer to the "Location" section of this document for weed control corrective action.

It was observed in this inspection that interim areas of the Location appear to have been seeded with smooth brome. Interim areas have not been recontoured to match the surrounding landscape; soil piles/berms are present. Soils in the interim areas appear very compacted. Penetration with a shovel was difficult and soils were dense and platy compared to undisturbed areas. Due to a lack of recontouring and decompaction, interim areas of the Location must be fully reclaimed during final reclamation.

Per 1004 Rules vegetative cover should reflect reference area forbs, shrubs and grasses and the Operator must use a seed mixture provided by the surface owner, or a mixture prescribed by the local soil conservation district.</p> <p>A flowline riser and power line were observed to the south. Both must be removed for final reclamation along with all other equipment.</p>
