Citation also carries pollution/waste liability insurance of \$20,000,000, and environmental related liability insurance of \$3,000,000 for all active wells and \$1,000,000 for all plugged and abandoned wells. Citation maintains \$1,135,000 in surety bonds with the COGCC. There is no site-specific financial assurance associated with this remediation project. Citation does not intend to file an insurance claim for this remediation project. This remediation project is very close to completion and is anticipated to be closed in Q3 of 2022.

OPERATOR COMMENT

On 4/20/22, Citation removed 28 yards of soil from the areas of Table 915-1 exceedances identified in Form 27 document ID 402919044. The sample points were then resampled for the Table 915-1 exceedances after contaminated soil was removed. AU_SS_03 was sampled for EC and SAR. AU_SS_04 was sampled for SAR and pH. AU_SS_05_SW was sampled for EC and SAR. AU_SS_06_SW was sampled for SAR.

Analytical results indicate several minor remaining inorganic exceedances. Analysis of AU_SS_03 indicated an EC value of 4.08 mmhos/cm and SAR value of 6.19. Analysis of AU_SS_04 and AU_SS_05_SW identified SAR Table 915-1 exceedances of 15.8 and 6.48, respectively.

Citation intends to resample points AU_SS_03 for EC and SAR; AU_SS_04 and AU_SS_05 will be resampled for SAR. Sampling will take place on the week of 6/20/22.
