Comment:	<p>It was observed in this inspection that one musk thistle (List B Noxious Weed) is present on Location. Inspector removed the plant. Cheatgrass (List C Noxious Weed) is widespread on portions of the Location, including on the southwestern fill slope, and in large patches throughout the eastern interim area. Field bindweed (List C Noxious Weed) is also present.</p> <p>A fall corrective action date is being given to allow for appropriate treatment of cheatgrass. Operator is encouraged to control weeds as quickly as possible, but also to determine the best method of weed control and implement at the appropriate time.</p>		
Corrective Action:	Conduct weed management to prevent further establishment and spread of noxious weeds and undesirable plant species; ongoing weed management required until location passes final reclamation.	Date:	11/15/2022

Comment	<p><u>Refer to the "Location" section of this inspection report for weed control corrective action.</u></p> <p><u>The eastern interim areas of the Location are not progressing towards non-invasive uniform plant cover of at least eighty (80) percent of pre-disturbance or reference area levels. While some of the eastern interim area is vegetated with perennials there are large patches throughout, and particularly at the southeast which are dominated by cheatgrass with very little perennial establishment. Previous inspection #692402003 observed this issue, giving a corrective action date of 6/15/20. It appears the Operator has not addressed the issue. A new corrective action date is being given to allow for fall seeding.</u></p>
Corrective Action	<p><u>Conduct additional reclamation on the eastern interim areas in accordance with 1003 Rules. Establish vegetation with total perennial, non-invasive uniform plant cover of at least eighty (80) percent of pre-disturbance or reference area levels on interim areas of the Location. Use a seed mixture requested by the surface owner, or a mixture prescribed by the local soil conservation district. Ensure erosion controls are implemented to stabilize the seeded soil, and continue to monitor and manage this site until Final Reclamation has passed. Revegetation activities shall be completed no later than 11/15/2022.</u></p>
