
Gentlemen:

Our records show that the above well is shut-in.

This is to advise that if the well is still shut-in at the next anniversary date (April 18, 1989), which is the end of the secondary term of the lease, a shut-in royalty will be due and payable in addition to the annual rental.

This shut-in royalty is at the rate of \$2/acre/year. Each year's shut-in royalty will be forfeited to Lessor except for the year during which the well begins production. The maximum extension of the lease due to the existence of a shut-in well shall be five years. Any further extensions shall be at the sole option of the Board.
