Comment Previous inspection observed noxious weeds establishing on the production areas, and slopes of the Location. Operator was required to comply with Rule 1003.f. Operator submitted Resolution #402720492 stating "noxious weeds sprayed 6/15/21".

It was observed in this inspection that Operator does not appear to be conducting ongoing Undesirable and Noxious Weed monitoring and management to prevent further spread/establishment of weeds; noxious weeds (bindweed) have continued to establish on the production areas and slopes of the Location. Additionally, Scotch thistle was observed establishing throughout the interim areas of the Location.

RECLAMATION COMMENT Though desirable perennial vegetation was observed within interim areas, vegetation establishing is predominantly annual grass species that 1) do not comport with, or contribute to Rule 1003.e standards and requirements, 2) do not provide long term stabilization, and 3) competes with desirable plant species. Continue to monitor and manage interim areas to ensure site progresses towards 1003 desirable perennial vegetative requirements.
