Attached to this letter is an application by Sundance Oil Co. for the drilling of a water well on the Mosbarger farm in Section 10, Township 3 South, Range 60 West, Adams County, Colorado.

We would like this application to be accepted in lieu of the one approved earlier by you - October 3, 1960. We were unable to re-enter the old Sinclair No. 1 Mosbarger dry hole, C SW NW, Section 10, T. 3S., R. 60W., Adams County, Colorado. When we opened the surface casing in this well we found it was making minor amounts of gas and oil, sufficient to contaminate and make unusable the Fox Hills water. Therefore, we recapped this well and now plan to drill a water well in the NW SW of Section 10.
