On January 10, 1951, Lane-Wells ran their Neutron and Gamma-Ray Log from surface to total depth of 5084. A continuous cement plug was then placed in the hole from 5084' back into the 7" casing to protect and seal off any possible gas or fluid bearing sands below the casing which was cemented at 4930. The cement plug consisted of 75 sacks regular cement, 2% calcium chloride and was allowed to set 18 hours before being checked. At the end of this period, a firm cement top was found at 4850 with tubing measurements. The cement was then drilled to 4917 at which point preparations were made to gun perforate.
