On December 29, 1950, drill stem test No. 2 was run on the above described well with the following results: Total depth 4993', packer set at 4983 $\frac{1}{2}$, tool open for 1 hour 20 minutes.

Recovered very small blow of air during the first 30 minutes of testing after which the blow increased slightly. The blow was not large enough to measure at any time with a pitot tube. The blow continued to be air throughout the test. When the drill pipe was pulled 20 ft. of drilling mud was recovered which had a very small gas odor but no indication of oil or water. The flowing pressure was recorded as zero with a 15 minute shut-in pressure of 530 psi.
