We propose to drill a well using rotary tools on above described location.

Approximately 200 feet of 10-3/4" O.D. 32.75# and 40.5# H-40 casing will be set as surface casing and cemented to the surface by an approved method.

A nine inch hole will then be drilled through the Dakota and Cheyenne formations then an electrical log will be run to total depth.

If any formation is found to be commercially productive, 7" O.D. 20 and 23# J-55 casing will be run through the productive formation and cemented with approximately 200 sacks cement by an approved method casing will be perforated and well produced.
