Good morning Scott and Richard-

Hope this note finds you well.

I am following up on the attached inspection, which notes the use of a domestic tap at the Youberg 23-24-6S-94W. Although the piping is housed in Mustang's meter house, the tap does not belong to Mustang nor does is the gas supplied by the Youberg 23-24. This was clarified with COGCC following a similar inspection in 2019, please see the attached email address. The tap belongs to TEP Rocky Mountain LLC.

Mustang kindly requests that COGCC discuss this with TEP to ensure that the tap is registered with them. I am not sure where to find on the COGCC website a list of registered flowlines. Can you direct me to this?
