INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Foundation is planning to document conditions beneath all equipment at the Columbine Sp Fed 15C-23-4-104 well location (ID: 316394) through observation and field screening when equipment is removed. Photos will be taken during removal of equipment and submitted on a Supplemental Form 27. Based on observations of staining or odor, Foundation will collect a minimum of one (1) soil sample from the area beneath each piece of equipment on location-- 1 wellhead, 1 produced water tank, 1 separator, and 1 meter shed. The off-location flowline associated with this well will be abandoned in place per Rule 1105.d. Locations where the flowline connects to the wellhead and riser will be investigated and soil samples will be collected from the areas most likely impacted by the flowline.

PROPOSED SAMPLING PLAN

A minimum of five (5) soil samples will be collected as part of the facility closure investigation, collected after each piece of equipment is removed from the location. The wellhead and tank samples will be analyzed for the full list of COGCC Table 915-1 constituents. If field screening indicates a negative hydrocarbon presence, Foundation is requesting a reduced analyte list consisting of TPH (GRO/DRO/ORO), BTEX, SAR, EC, and pH for the separator, meter shed, and flowline samples.
