The well is located 330 ft. (N) of South line and 330 ft. (E) of west line (S) (W)

The elevation above sea level is 4300 ft. estimated.

Details of Plan of Work: (State names of and expected depths to objective sands: Show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work.)

To drill the well to a sufficient depth to test the "J" sand of the Granerous Group expected at approximately 5200 feet. Drill a 15" hole sufficient to set approximately 200' of 10-3/4" O.D. 32# surface pipe cemented with 160 sacks. Drill a 9" hole to approximately 5200 feet. DST all significant shows of oil and or gas. Run electric log to total depth. Set 5 1/2" O.D. 15 1/2# casing, through the producing zone, cement with 200 sacks. Perforate the production string for production as indicated by electric log and D.S.T. evaluation.
