Good afternoon Joseph,

Thank you for this consolidated table of upcoming Form 4s (maintenance work) and Form 6s (P&A work), and for the opportunity for CPW to comment since these locations are within one or more High Priority Habitats. CPW also appreciates that you are proactively scheduling your work outside of the sensitive seasons.

I reviewed and concur with your HPH intersects, with the exception of the red text below.

I approve of these timing stipulations but would ask you to please prioritize the work within the 0.25 Bald Eagle buffer ASAP, then followed by the 0.5 Bald Eagle buffer, followed by BEWNR, Mule Deer, and last ANSCW. Please let me know (with at least 2 weeks' notice) if you anticipate that work will go into any of the Bald Eagle timing buffers.

Otherwise, this should conclude the CPW consult task. If Oxy and/or COGCC have any further questions about any of these, please let me know.

Hey Brandon,

In preparation for our meeting Thursday I took the liberty of summarizing all the emails I have sent you over the last month for discussion. Below is a list of the locations we are waiting on. If we received approval we would likely move on them sooner than the proposed date. I have included our BMPs list as well. We will apply the BMPs below based on the HPH noted in the table when the form is submitted or discussed with the COGCC (if already submitted). Give the cycle time of this process and that of COGCC, we are rapidly running out of time to complete the work below outside the STIP window.

The BMPs we will be including for the locations below:

.25/.5mi Bald Eagle Nest: KMOG will not conduct operations related to this form between 12/1 – 7/31

BEWNR: KMOG will not conduct operation related to this form between 11/15 – 3/15.

- For those locations in the both .5mi BE & BEWNR the STIP is 11/15 – 7/31

ANSCW: KMOG will implement stormwater BMPs (Including the use of straw wattle) during operations to prevent sediment from leaving the location.

Mule Deer (MD): Between 12/1 through 4/30, KMOG will only perform rig operations during daylight hours, Monday through Friday. KMOG access roads have speed limit restrictions that all personnel will follow. KMOG will shut down operations if an extreme winter storm is anticipated.
