Subject: Priority Habitat Buffer Restrictions for a Cleanup Project (MCU #43 Injection Line in Jackson County, CO)

Good Afternoon Taylor,

I hope you have been doing well since we last spoke. We are working on a soil cleanup project for an oil and gas client, and we identified that the site is located within a few priority habitat buffers: Greater Sage Grouse Priority Habitat Management Area buffer is located over the site; Pronghorn Migration Corridors buffer is mapped over the site; Greater Sage Grouse General Habitat Management Area is mapped 555 feet north of the site; Greater Sage Grouse Lek Site buffers. Our planned field activities include excavating impacted soil, soil sampling, and backfill of excavation with clean fill. We wanted to double-check that there are not restrictions on these activities. I've included site information below to allow you to make a determination.
