Well is to be drilled through the Dakota series, estimated to be a total depth  
of 6700 feet. 400 feet of 10-3/4" surface pipe to be cemented from top to bottom  
7" 23# casing, or 5-1/2" 15# casing, if test of the well shows it to be productive  
of oil or gas - otherwise, heavy mud will be left in the hole and cement plug will  
be set at the bottom of the surface casing.
