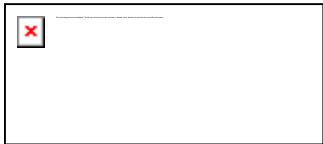

Good Afternoon Brandon,

We are working on a soil cleanup project for an oil and gas client, and we identified that the site is located within a few priority habitat buffers: Greater Sage Grouse General and Priority Habitat Management Areas, Pronghorn Migration Corridors buffer, and Greater Sage Grouse Lek Site. Additionally, Pronghorn Winter Concentration buffer is approximately 275 feet northwest of the site. Our planned field activities include backfilling a roadside excavation with clean fill. We wanted to double-check that there are not restrictions on these activities. I've included site information below to allow you to make a determination.

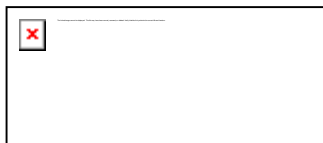
