Dear Mr. Carroll:

Concerning the #13-28 Price well located NWSW 28-3S-59W: verbal approval to plug this well was given by this office on 6/29/87. An inspection conducted by this office on 7/7/87 confirmed that subject well was plugged. On 7/21/87 by U.S. mail you were requested to submit all required information no later than 8/29/87. You were contacted by phone again on 9/22/87 by this office and your office said the information would be submitted in one week. We have received no response to our requests. This information was due thirty (30) days after work was performed and should not have to be requested.

You are hereby directed to submit the Final Plugging and Abandonment Sundry Notice (OGCC Form 4), Completion Report (OGCC Form 5), Cement Verification (invoice, receipt, or cementer's log), and one copy of all electric logs run within seven (7) days of receipt of this letter. Should you fail to submit this information the matter will be recommended for Hearing before the Commission at the next available date for you to show cause why you should not be held in violation of the Commission Rules and Regulations and fined in accordance with Section 34-60-121 of the Colorado Revised Statutes.

Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 34-60-121, state that any person who violates any rule of the Commission shall be subject to a penalty of not more than one thousand dollars (\$1000) for each violation and for each day such violation continues.
