A weld on a produced water loadline failed resulting in approximately 250 bbls of a produced water and crude oil combination being released inside of a lined secondary containment. Vac trucks were dispatched to being removing the pooled fluid. The integrity of the liner will be verified prior to replacing ballast material. If impacts are discovered beneath the liner, the soil will be removed and confirmation soil samples will be collected in compliance with COGCC Table 915-1.
