Comment There is a historic spill area that extends 180' north from the tank battery site. A form 27 with sampling results was submitted since previous reclamation inspection. It appears gypsum was applied to impacted soils which may not be an effective treatment in dry climates. The impacted area has no vegetation growth. Additional sampling needs to be performed at greater depth to determine soil issues in vegetation root zone.
