NOTICE AND APPLICATION FOR HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to Rule 522.e, the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission" or "COGCC") Staff hereby applies to the Commission for an Order Finding Violation ("OFV") against Crestone Peak Resources LLC (Operator No. 10633) ("Crestone"). The Commission has scheduled this matter for hearing before a COGCC Hearing Officer at the date, time, and location stated below. This Notice and Application is being served to adjudicate the allegations made in the below-described Notice of Alleged Violation No. 401941746 ("NOAV"), the allegations of which are incorporated herein.

On February 15, 2019, COGCC Staff issued the NOAV to Crestone for a violation of § 34-60-121(1)(a) C.R.S. - Permit Violation, for exceeding the permitted surface disturbance at Location ID 305447.

COGCC Staff requests that the Commission: (1) find that Crestone is in violation of the Rule cited above; (2) order Crestone to return to compliance; (3) assess a penalty pursuant to Rule 523; and (4) impose other necessary and appropriate relief as authorized by law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado under § 34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to § 34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the Colorado Administrative Procedures Act at § 24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's Series 500 Rules at 2 CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled this matter for hearing before a COGCC Hearing Officer at the following date, time, and location (subject to change):
