In regard to your request of September 24, 1969, previously answered on the Wear No. 1 Well, we have reviewed the information you furnished us on the USA No. 1 Well at subject location.

As in the case of the other well, we find no production of potable water from the Topeka, Lansing and Marmaton formations. Being assured that the casing and cementing program will be such as to prevent pollution of the existing potable water, as well as pollution of the questionable supply of potable water from the Dakota formation, we concur in your recommending such disposal and see no problems as far as administration of the water is concerned.
