J. M. Huber Corporation is the operator of the Stubbs #1 located in the NW NW Section 15-T19S-R45W and the Pyles #1 located in C SE SW Section 10-T19S-R45W, Kiowa County, Colorado. Both of these wells are completed in and producing from the Lansing formation.

We recognize the need for underground disposal of produced salt water but, we feel that disposal of salt water as proposed by International Nuclear Corporation in the Lansing formation may upset formation balance within the Lansing and cause premature abandonment of our two producing wells. Therefore, we object to the application as submitted by International Nuclear for disposal in the U.S.A. #1 Lansing formation. We not object to disposal of produced salt water into the Arbuckle a non-productive formation as International Nuclear plans in their Wear #1.
