Attached is the following information which was requested by Mr. Bob Egan of your office.

Butler #1 Sundry notice for recompletion in the Lansing L-13.

Butler #2 Well sign has been corrected to reflect that lease has fee ownership of both minerals and land.

Butler Lease Approval June 6, 1972 by State of Colorado for application of earthen pit. The copy in BLM files dated August 21, 1974, by J. C. Simmons was to notify the State of an upgrade on the pit; the pit was lined with a neoprene liner.

USA #2-15 Sundry notices for Change of Operator and Temporary Abandoned status of well. We are re-evaluating the well logs to determine if any productive zones are present. Also, for your files is a copy of the completion report. We do not have any production information on the well; you will have to contact Tenneco to get that information. Our estimates indicate it produced less than 3,000 barrels of oil and less than 20,000 barrels of water.

Butler Lease Hydrogen Sulfide Contingency Plan - We have contracted Oilind Safety to put together a H2S contingency plan and will forward it to your attention as soon as its completed.

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COLORADO OIL & GAS CONS. COMM.

Previous testing has shown very low concentrations of H<sub>2</sub>S.
