Dear Mr. Seward:

On January 1, 1987, March 24, 1987 and September 1, 1987 you reportedly assumed operations of the subject well(s) from CGT, Inc., J. M. McCool and Prima Exploration, Inc., respectively. Since that time you have been contacted several times regarding the posting of security as required by Rule 304 of the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations.

In addition to setting the security required, the rule provides that the successor operator of a well(s) must replace the previous operator's security within thirty (30) days after assuming operations of the well(s). As of the date of this letter we have not received this security.

In the event that you have not posted adequate security by March 1, 1988, the matter will be taken before the Commission with the specific recommendation that a penalty for violation of Rule 304 be imposed as they deem appropriate.
