## REMARKS:

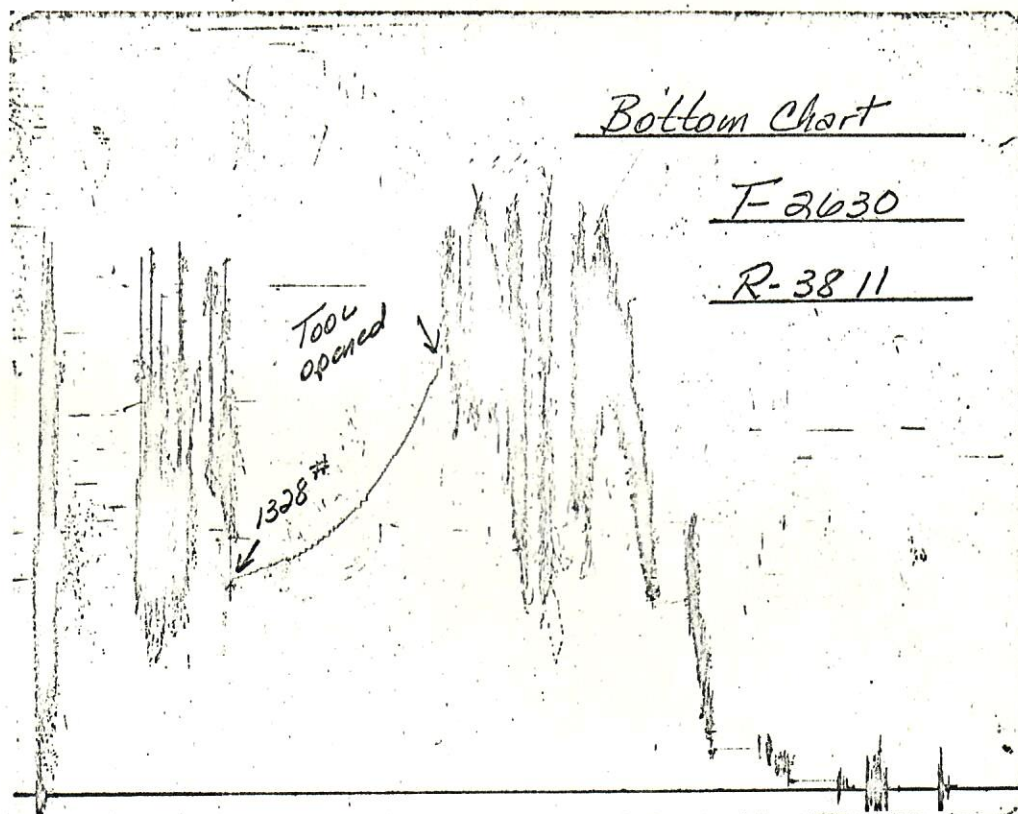
1st Flow - Tool opened with a weak blow, increasing to a strong blow (bubble hose on bottom of bucket) in 3 minutes.
