Completed in the "J" sand as a pumping well. Drilled 15" hole to 135'. Cemented 10 3/4" casing at 131' RB. Drilled to TD of 5047'. Core #1, 4966-89', rec. 23'. Core #2, 5016-37', rec. 21'. Ran tester, packer set at 5107', tool open 1 hr., SI 15 min., rec. 3590' clean oil, 10' oil cut mud. Ran 5 1/2" casing, landed at 5046' RB. Perforated 5018-36' w/6-1/2" shots. Ran 2 7/8" tubing, landed at 5022'. Rig released 9-22-54.

Initial pumping potential on 24 hour test, 290 BOPD, 54" stroke, 20 Strokes per minute, 1 1/2" pump. Gravity 41.
