On 04/10/2023 at approximately 10:14 hours, I, Compliance Specialist, Wayne Smelser

Conducted a follow up Inspection at TEP ROCKY MOUNTAIN LLC CLOUGH RMV 203-20 pad.

API # 045-07124

Location # 323961 in Garfield County Colorado.

Please refer to Inspection 708900240 conducted on 04/07/2023, previous corrective action has not been completed.

Location is within High Priority/Density Habitat areas.

Access road is still washed out & I'm unable to access the location.

The following compliance issue was observed:

1. No access to location with a CA date of 04/08/2023

At this time I'm still unable to access this location or any other locations further up the lease road. The access road has severe degradation & erosion & is washed out. While I was on the road doing my inspection I observed a MultiChem truck driving through the washed out access road, please refer to photo log. I had previously called the TEP emergency phone number on 04/07/2023 at 12:31 hours & left a message with the TEP answering service. I told them the condition of the road, that it was affecting waters of the state & that I had no access. I further stated that I was issuing a 24 hour corrective action & that TEP either needed to fix the road immediately or shut down access & stop people from driving through until it was fixed because it was affecting waters of the state. The employee at the answering service took my phone number & said she'd inform someone at TEP. I told her that TEP needed to return my call ASAP. At the time of this follow up Inspection I still haven't heard from TEP on the matter.

A follow up on this site inspection needs to be conducted to ensure the compliance issues have been corrected to comply with COGCC rules.
