
Dear Director Murphy:

In accordance with Rule 218.f.1., Transfer of Operatorship-Subsequent, Petro Operating Company, LLC (Petro), Buying Operator, would like to inform the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) that Colton Limited Liability, Co.
