Comment:

The vegetation has not established at the location and there are large areas that have no vegetation. It appears there could be a historic impact to soils from the abandoned wellsite. Operator will need to submit a form 27 to investigate and sample soils per Rule 913. All disturbed areas must be properly decompacted by cross ripping to a depth of 18 inches, have an adequate seedbed prepared, and then seeded with a seed mixture that reflects the surrounding vegetation. Establish vegetation with total perennial, non-invasive uniform plant cover of at least eighty (80) percent of pre-disturbance or reference area levels. Continue to monitor and maintain the location until the final reclamation requirements are achieved.
