WATER PLAN

St. Croix Operating, Inc. (St. Croix), has drafted this plan in accordance with 304.c.(18).

Recycled water will be used for drilling operations. This well will not be hydraulically fractured. This will not use any water for completion operations.

Freshwater will be used for dust mitigation. St. Croix will purchase the freshwater from the City of Wray.

St. Croix's primary source of water is intended to be recycled water from producing wells near to the proposed location. The produced water will be brought to location via pipelines. No trucking is anticipated to deliver water for drilling.

Prior to spud, St. Croix will submit via Form 4 analytical of the recycled water to be utilized to show compliance with Table 437-1.

St. Croix is proposing one vertical well for this location. The well is anticipated to use 4,215 barrels for drilling. The well will use 0 barrels of water for completion operations.
