Hi Ken – Thanks for the quick response. Below is a map of the three wells we are planning to work on. These wells were plugged and abandoned in the 1970s. We plan to send a workover rig (a small rig) to these wells to drill out the old cement and re-cement more of the wellbore in order to get it up to our and the Colorado Oil and Gas Commission standards, for the purpose of fracing a new pad in the area. The previous cement jobs did not adequately cover the Niobrara formation, the formation we will be fracing, so we will be placing cement over that formation along with numerous other plugs throughout the wellbore.

This works takes on average 12 days per well, could be shorter or longer depending on the state the wellbore was left in by the previous operator. There will be a workover rig along with support equipment to perform the work. Once the well is re-plugged, we will weld a plate on it, cut it below grade, and reclaim the surface to your liking.

The first step is locating the well, sometimes these wells are not at the exact coordinates documented. So we will have a surveyor come out with a metal detector, dig up the well, and shoot accurate coordinates so we can send the rig to perform the work.

We are looking at the late May or June timeframe right now, once we get the well located, permit approved by the State, we will contact you for a more accurate timeline of when the rig will be there.

All we need to proceed is for you to give us permission to come survey and permission to move in a rig on your surface when it is time.

Please let me know if you have any more questions about the operations.
