 To date, 578 cubic yards of impacted material excavated from grade to 20 ft below ground surface has been transported to Greenleaf Environmental Services for offsite disposal. Manifests will be supplied upon request.  
 On 5/26/2022, a battery operated (charged via solar panels) soil vapor extraction blower was plumbed into a two inch well identified by SVE-01 advanced through the impacted area directly beneath the point of release and activated.
