## INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

Pursuant to COGCC Rule 911 a site investigation was conducted pertaining to the LOUSTALET B15-15X wellhead cut and cap and flowline removal. Approximately 1340' of flowline will be removed. The COGCC will be updated in a supplemental Form 27 if a portion of the flowline is abandoned-in-place due to field constraints. The wellhead will be cut and capped per COGCC rules. The Flowline Pre-Abandonment Notice Document number is included under Related Forms.

Two grab soil samples were collected for analysis by a certified laboratory for TPH (total volatile [C6-C10] and extractable [C10-C36] hydrocarbons) organic compounds in soil per COGCC Table 915-1, and EC, SAR, pH, and boron. Additionally, soil sample FS01@4' was analyzed for Table 915-1 metals.

One groundwater sample was collected at the base of the excavation for analysis of organic parameters in groundwater.

A Site Assessment was conducted to delineate impacted media at the facility. A total of five soil borings were advanced in the area of impacts. Soil samples were collected and analyzed for TPH (total volatile [C6-C10] and extractable [C10-C36] hydrocarbons), organic compounds in soil per COGCC Table 915-1, and pH, EC, SAR, and boron. Each of the five soil borings were converted to temporary groundwater monitoring wells. Five groundwater samples were collected and analyzed for BTEX, naphthalene, 1,2,4-trimethylbenzene, 1,3,5-trimethylbenzene, and inorganic parameters.
