Form 27 for the decommission of the PURITAN 2N68W 34SESE (336413) facility was submitted and recently approved. Wildlife Consultant has completed various surveys of the location. Based off the information collected, it has been confirmed that this location is currently not occupied by burrowing owls and there is no evidence of active nests. At this time, there are no restrictions to when additional work is scheduled in terms of wildlife. Wildlife Consultant stated that they will conduct follow-up surveys as needs based on project timing.. Thus, Operator will now proceed with removing equipment to comply with Rule 606.a.
