Good morning Alicia and Taylir,

I have review the above captioned Form 9 Transfer and have noted the following issues.

Issue 1 – The Wells and Facilities Proposed and Transfer lists are not numbered sequentially but rather grouped by location.

Solution 1 - Please resubmit the Wells and Facilities Proposed and Wells and Facilities Transferred lists, numbering the items sequentially.

Issue 2 – Gas Facilities are not transferred on the Form 9.

Solution 2 – Gas Facilities are transferred on the Form 12. Please remove the Gas Processing Plant from the Wells and Facilities Proposed and the Wells and Facilities Transferred lists. The staff

contact for the Form 12 is Ellice Devine, ellice.devine@state.co.us.

Issue 3 – The Incidents Proposed and the Incidents Transferred lists are not numbered sequentially but rather grouped by location.

Solution 3 - Please resubmit the Incidents Proposed and Incidents Transferred lists, numbering the items sequentially.

Issue 4 – The Buyer Notified Local Govt. Attestation did not list who was notified at Huerfano County.

Solution 4 – Please resubmit the Buyer Notified Local Govt. Attestation listing the person contacted or Local Government Designee in the attestation.

Assuming the other Form 9 requirements are met, all Form 9s shall now be passed with the following two COAs:

The Buying Operator must file a *Form 3, Financial Assurance Plan*, within 10 business days of Form 9 approval. Per Rule 702, Buyer will then provide any required additional financial assurance as soon as practicable but no later than 90 days from the Commission's approval of the *Form 3, Financial Assurance Plan*.

The Selling Operator must file a *Form 3, Financial Assurance Plan* within 10 business days of Form 9 approval. Per Rule 702, Seller will then provide any required additional financial assurance as soon as practicable but no later than 90 days from the Commission's approval of the *Form 3, Financial Assurance Plan*.
