10-5-54 - Spudded and cemented 8-5/8" casing at 256' with 160 sacks cement.
 10-11-54- DST No. 1 4539 to 4547, open 95 minutes with string blowout test. Recovered 1740' very slightly gas cut water with scum dead oil in top 270 feet. DST No. 2 4447 to 4456 feet, open 20 minutes with immediate strong blow, gas to surface in 2 minutes at estimated 3200 MCF per day. Recovered 15 feet of water and gas cut mud. Ran heavy mud from total depth (4560) to 271', cement from 271 to 241 feet, mud from 241 to 10 feet, cement from 10 feet to surface, in such a manner as will not interfere with surface cultivation.
