Dear Mr. Gottenborg,

As a result of a Weld County tax sale I understand that you will be retrieving the equipment and casing from the Long #1,2, and 3 in the near future. I have approved the plugging of the wells in question on October 18, 1991, copies of which were sent to your office. As a condition of the plugging operations the pits must be backfilled, leveled and debris removed from the locations. The lease roads appear to have been addressed through surface damage payments and in the Oil and Gas Lease on record at Weld County and are not a part of the location cleanup requirements.

We agree to assist in the partial payment of the plugging costs for these three wells and location cleanup. The cleanup does not include removal of the lease road since the surface owner is also the mineral owner in all three cases. I discussed this and confirmed this with Dennis Bicknell. I sent letters to Mr. Long on November 7, 1990 and on August 27, 1991 and was not notified by anyone in regard to those letters or concerns about damages. I have attached copies of those letters for your information.

I will need all invoices showing actual plugging costs to justify any payment from the OGCC Environmental Response Fund. These costs should be sent to this office after the plugging operations have been completed.
