Dear Mr. Miers:

It will be necessary to withhold approval to drill the Atkins No. 1 until the following requirements of the rules and regulations are satisfied.

A \$75.00 drilling fee should be submitted with the intention to drill. This is in accordance with Rule 303.

In addition, it has been noted that the location of your well is less than the 600 feet minimum requirement to the nearest property or lease line. It is stated in Rule 316 that a well shall not be located less than 600 feet from any lease line unless there is a waiver or consent signed by the lease owner toward whom the well is moved. In this case it will be necessary to have a waiver or consent from the lease owners of the SW/4 NE/4 and the N/2 SE/4, Section 4.

This matter should be taken care of as soon as possible in order that you may be able to obtain approval and commence drilling without a violation of the rules and regulations of the Commission.


We have attempted to contact you by phone several times, but have not been successful.
