Groundwater less than 20 ft is not expected at the disturbance location.

This location is within a 2023 Proposed HPH Mule Deer Severe Winter Range Area. Per NTO from Jan. 4, 2023 titled CPW CONSULTATION PROCESS FOR OPERATIONS IN WILDLIFE HABITATS AT EXISTING OIL AND GAS LOCATIONS, CPW consultation not required.

## INITIAL ACTION SUMMARY

Description of initial action or emergency response measures take to abate, investigate, and/or remediate impacts associated with E&P Waste.

A site investigation will be conducted pursuant to COGCC rule 911 at the ARISTOCRAT ANGUS-63N65W 3NWSE (305580) oil and gas location pertaining to the cut/cap of the ARISTOCRAT ANGUS 2-4-3X (05-123-23190) and abandonment of the ARISTOCRAT ANGUS 2-4-3X (12323190\_FL) wellhead line. See site map exhibit for details.

## PROPOSED SAMPLING PLAN

### Proposed Soil Sampling

Will soil samples be collected as part of this investigation? ( Number, type (grab/composite), analyses, and locations of samples ):

Grab confirmation soil samples will be collected from beneath the wellhead and flowline start/end points. Depending on soil type and piping material, potholes will be dug approximately every 50-150 feet along the flowline path. Potholes will never be more than 200 feet apart. These observation points will be photographed and field screened. Additional soil samples will be collected when flowline repairs are observed, changes in flow direction, or when there is a change in the flowline material type. Soil samples will be analyzed by a certified laboratory for TPH (total volatile [C6-C10] and extractable [C10-C36] hydrocarbons), organic compounds in soil per COGCC Table 915-1, and EC, SAR, pH, and boron. All samples collected will be analyzed by a certified laboratory using approved COGCC laboratory analysis methods.
