- C. A description of any threat to Waters of the State, Public Water Systems, residences or occupied structures, livestock, wildlife, air quality, or publicly-maintained roads from the Spill or Release; and
- D. Any information available to the Operator about the type and volume of Fluid or waste involved, including whether it is controlled or uncontrolled at the time of the 24 Hour Notification.

Good afternoon, I am providing notification of a recent spill at Crestone Peak Resources' Regnier Farms 19H-B268 location. Please see details below.

Description: A compromised produced water dump line at the Regnier Farms 1J-19H separator resulted in 0.27 bbls of fluid to be spilled to the surface and a currently unknown volume to the subsurface. The impacted soil will be removed following utility locates and hauled for disposal. Confirmation soil samples will be collected in compliance with COGCC Table 915-1. Additionally, a waste characterization sample from the source area will be collected and submitted for analysis of COGCC Table 915-1 constituents. An initial Form 19 will be submitted within 72 hours of discovery (7/17/2023).
