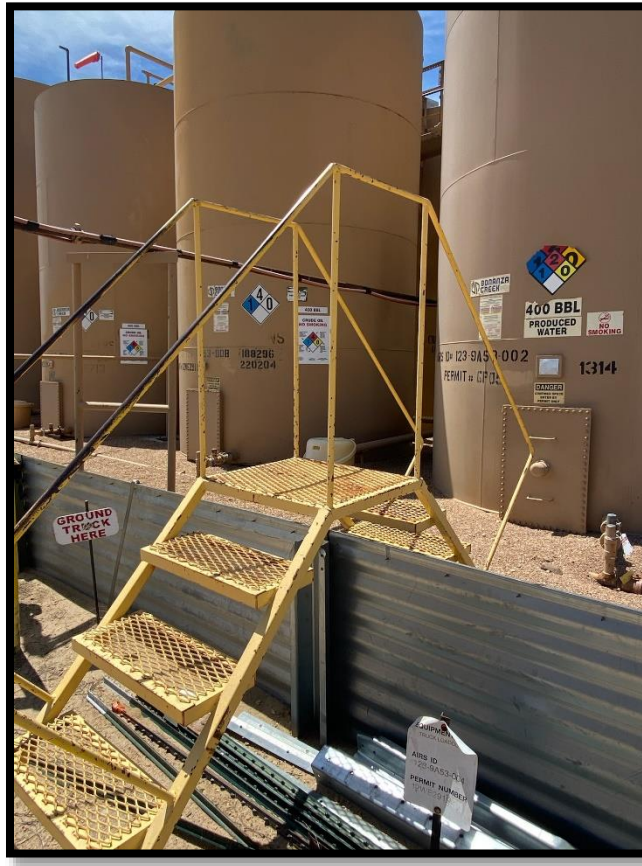

**CA:** East 400 BBL Crude Oil Tanks - Content and Capacity Labels have faded; see photos. Install sign to comply with Rule 605.h.

**CA Resolution:** Operator has provided photo evidence and noted the two Crude Oil Tanks have new capacity/content labels installed to comply with Rule 605.h.

**CA:** Unused Production Equipment/Parts on East Side of Location; see photos. Comply with Rule 606.

**CA Resolution:** Operator has reported that there is active maintenance going on at this facility and this equipment will be reinstalled on the tank battery when completed.

**CA:** Locate Line Flags on Location; see photos. Comply with Rule 606.

**CA Resolution:** Operator has requested that the current locate line flags remain in place as there is additional digging is likely to be needed. Field will be sure to remove these flags when maintenance has been completed to comply with Rule 606.
