Filled hole with heavy rotary mud to 290 ft. Set plug. Dumped in 1/2 sack hulls. Mixed 20 sacks cement by hand. Poured same in hole. Filled hole with heavy rotary mud to 40 ft. Set plug. Dumped in 1/2 sack hulls. Mixed 10 sacks cement by hand. Poured same in hole, which filled hole to bottom of cellar.
