1. Existing Roads: Access route to the general area is marked on the attached portion of U.S.G.S. National Topographic Map (Trinidad) 1:250000 scale. A portion of U.S.G.S. Quadrangle Map (Little Sheep Mountain) is also attached, marked to show roads which will need to be improved (Federal and Fee) and road to location which will be constructed.
2. Planned Access Road: The planned access road to be constructed is marked on the attached portion of the Quadrangle Map. The existing trail, which begins on the north line of Section 13, will require improvements for about 1.4 miles. Approximately the first half is across Federal lands and the last half is across the lands of Mr. R. W. Walker. The approximately 1000' of road to location to be constructed is across the lands of Mr. Walker.
3. Existing Wells: There are two wells in the vicinity (1 $\frac{1}{2}$  mile radius) both shown on the attached Quadrangle map and both on Fee Lands. The well shown as No. 3, NW SW Section 11, was a dry hole. The well in NW SE of Section 15 is a shut-in CO<sub>2</sub> well, shut in due to no market.
4. Lateral Roads: As shown on the attached maps.
