This well was initially proposed to be drilled 2500' f/South and 2000' f/West lines Section 14-27S-70W, Huerfano County, Colorado. Mr. D. V. Rogers, Director, Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission, approved the Application to Drill Feb. 17, 1976, Permit No. 76 100, API #05-055-6032. Mr. E. W. Guynn, District Engineer, U.S.G.S., approved the Application to Drill for Unit purposes on Feb. 17, 1976.

A review of the available geological control indicates moving the surface location approx. 500' west would give a more favorable geologic position. It is now proposed to drill the well at the location shown above. Certified Location Plat Attached.

Research analysis indicates wells in this area can be satisfactorily drilled with a "Low Lime" drilling fluid and it is now proposed to drill this well with the "Low Lime" drilling fluid instead of the oil base drilling fluid. Otherwise there are no changes from the initial Application.
